

**There are many things we already automatically do in our daily lives to look out for each other, keep each other safe. Here's a quick reminder:**

- ♀ Keep the number for Rape Relief and other transition houses or women's groups handy so that you can call for support and information should you need it.
- ♀ Share access to cars - we already car-pool our kids - we can do it for each other too.
- ♀ If a man is attacking a woman in her home, on the street, do not be afraid to call 911. The police must take violence against women seriously and respond immediately.
- ♀ If it is safe to do so, we can gather a couple other women and intervene, use our voices to tell him to stop, write down his description to give the police.
- ♀ Offer our homes and phones to each other to get safe in the moment, while we gather up resources to stay safe.
- ♀ Walk with women we don't know on the street - just go up and offer a walking partner for the time we are walking on the same street together.
